Answer: Arrival of Tourists from Different Countries The graph shows the arrival of tourists in Bangladesh from five countries during the years between 2004 and 2008. These countries are Australia, Japan, France, UK, and the USA. At a glance, the graph shows that the highest number of tourists come from the UK, and there is an increasing trend from the year 2004 to 2007. In 2004 a total of 19605 tourists from the UK visit Bangladesh. This number is increased to 23510 in 2005. This number is again increased to 29106 in 2006 and again it is increased to 34087 in 2007. But next year, that is in 2008, the number is decreased to 28805. The graph shows that the lowest number of tourists come from France and there are no regular trends of increase or decrease over the years. The graph shows that 2263 tourists come to Bangladesh from France in 2004. The number is increased to 2453 in 2005 but the number falls to 233.6 in 2006. Again, the number is decreased to 2289 in 2007. In 2008 it is increased to 2488. The graph shows that the second highest visitors come from the USA. In 2004 the number of tourists coming from the USA is 11358. This number is increased and decreased a little over the next few years and in 2008 it became 13822. Second, in lowest in Australia. In 2004 the tourists coming from Australia is 2684, and in 2008 it is 3409. Japan has been in the middle position. In 2004 the number of tourists coming from Japan is 7838 and the number changes a little up to 2008. Thus, the graph shows a clear picture of the
