Paragraph on Florist as a Career

Question: Write a paragraph on 'Florist as a Career'. Your paragraph should include the answers to the following questions.

Who is a florist? How is the career of a florist? What qualities do you need to have for a florist's job? How do most florists learn the trade? How does a florist make arrangement of flowers?

Answer: A florist is a person who handles flowers professionally. In Bangladesh being a florist is still considered an unconventional job. But it is not a bad career in the sense that a florist earns his living working among the daisies, violets, tulips, marigolds, dhalias, bellies, roses, and all other flowers. To be a florist one needs not to have any formal education or diploma. But s/he must have a good taste, good eye for colors, shapes, and proportion.
