## Paragraph on How to Keep Books in Order

Question: Suppose, your younger sister does not know how to keep her books in order on the table into the bookshelf. Now write a paragraph telling her how to keep books in order on the table and into the bookshelf. You can use the following keywords.

Answer: My younger sister has been reading in class ten. She does not know how to keep her books in order on the table and into the bookshelf. It looks very odd. Sometimes she misses her book.
