Answer: Bangladesh is a South Asian Country. It has a common border with India on the west, the north, and the east, and Myanmar on the southeast. The Bay of Bengal lies on the south of Bangladesh. On 16 December, 1971 'Bangladesh' came into being, as an independent country on the world map. Almost all the people of Bangladesh speak Bangla as their first language. The majority of the people in Bangladesh are Muslims. There are also the Hindus, the Christians, and the Buddhists. Besides, there are many tribal people who have their own religions and culture. Bangladesh has a tropical monsoon-type climate, with a hot and rainy summer and a dry winter. January is the coolest month and April is the warmest month. As Bangladesh is an agricultural country, the majority of the people live in agriculture. However, there are people of various other occupations. A significant number of educated people depend on government or private services. Many people are engaged in trade and business. People of all professions and all communities live here in peace and amity.

Our Homeland (Bangladesh)

Bangladesh is a small low-lying country in South Asia on the Bay of Bengal. Its total area is ,570 square kilometers. The Bay of Bengal is to the south of the country. The other three sides are surrounded by India except for a small strip in the southeast by Myanmar. Most of its lands are plain with some hilly areas in the northeast and southeast of the country. The country is crisscrossed by so many rivers and canals. The Padma, the Meghna, and the Jamuna are the main big rivers of the country. The country has a tropical monsoon climate. The country has six seasons. They are winter, spring, summer, rain, autumn, and late autumn. The population of Bangladesh is about 125 million. The majority of them are Muslims and the rest are Hindus, Buddhists, and Christians. Over 98 percent of the people speak Bengali. English is also widely used. The national dress for men is Payjama and Panjabi and Sari are for women. But the educated people put on pants and shirts, and the educated women put on Salowar and Kamiz. The economy of the country depends on agriculture. Jute, rice, tea, sugarcane, oilseeds. fruit, vegetables, spices, wheat, potato, tobacco, and cotton are the cash crops of the country.
